It has very good emulsification and suspension properties to leave washed articles cleaner and brighter. **DO NOT USE ON WOOLLEN OR SILK GARMENTS.**

Application

- LAUNDRY BREAK is designed to be dispensed by the Agar Laundry Liquid Automatic Feed System. This electronic equipment utilises pumps which are activated by the washing machine at appropriate points in the wash cycle. This system is safe because it does away with manual handling of chemicals, and economical because the correct quantity is measured out every time.
- The quantity of LAUNDRY BREAK to be used depends on the size of the machine and its load, the type of garments, the degree of soiling, the wash temperature and dip levels.
- Your Agar Representative can provide complete technical advice on the correct use of this product to suit the particular needs of your laundry.

Disposal Information

1. Used solutions -

Used Solutions of LAUNDRY BREAK should be poured into a drain or trough that leads to the sewer system or a septic tank. These systems have a method for treating and breaking down the waste. Used solutions of detergent should not be poured into stormwater drains or down driveways as these drains are designed for rainwater and ultimately lead to the local river system.

2. Unused product

It is best to keep the product and use it up! If this is not possible, try to give it to someone who can use it. (Make sure the product is in its original, labelled container).

If there is no alternative but disposal, it is safe to pour modest quantities of this product down the drain (to sewer) with running water. Leave the cold tap running for a few moments afterwards as this dilutes the product and reduces the concentration in the wastewater.

Remember, do not mix different cleaning products together during disposal!

3. Empty packaging

Bottles and drums

Our 5L and 20L bottles and drums are made from HDPE (polyethylene) or PET which can be recycled. You can dispose of these containers via the kerbside collection program or other recycling system.
